This a juried art show open to residents of Oregon and Washington State. Nonrefundable \$10 jury fee application is due no later than April 1, 2017.

No more than two artists may share a booth and art must be compatible. Both must be juried in and send in separate applications and jury fees. You will share the booth fee of \$100.

Jury results will be sent out by June 1, 2017.

If accepted into the art show, there is a \$100 exhibit fee which includes your booth space (10' x 10') and publicity for the Oregon City Festival of the Arts. Please note: this is an outdoor event on the grass, no electricity. (A \$35 fee will be charged for any check returned by the Artist's bank.)
